### **Independent Auditor's Report**

To the Members of METROCHEM CAPITAL TRUST LIMITED Report On the Financial Statement

### 3. STOCK IN TRADE:

Stock-in-trade is valued scrip wise at book value or market price whichever is lower.

#### 4. FIXED ASSETS:

All the Fixed Assets are stated at cost less depreciation after taking into consideration the Lease Adjustment Account.

#### 5. DEPRECIATION:

Depreciation of fixed assets is provided on Straight Line Method at rates and in the manner specifiedin Schedule II to the Companies Act, 2013

6. Retirement Benefits are accounted as and when the liability accrues.
